Sunday night the Gloucester Griffins started their 30th junior B lacrosse season downing the a Cornwall Celtics 9-7 in front of a crowd of nearly 300 at the Si Miller Arena in Cornwall.

The Celtics had a 2-1 lead after one period, and it was 6-5 for Gloucester after two sessions.

The third period was about missed opportunities for the Celtics, especially when on the power play and trailing 9-6 midway in the frame. The Griffins opened a window up for the Celtics with about three solid minutes of penalties, but goalie Alex Ince played a very solid game shutting down the home team.

"The Griffins have great expectations in 2007," said Coach Mike Roy. "We have a fair amount of veterans back, and we're better because of some of the midget talent that's come up. We started rebuilding two years ago with 17-year-olds. Now a lot of these guys are 19. We're hoping to have a good year."

Andrew Dillworth, was selected the Griffins game star, had two goals and four assists in the contest, which had an announced attendance of 287.

Other scores for the Griffins included Krystian Seguin with a pair, and Matt Degagne, Dave Lapense, Rick Mineault, Matt Lavoie and Chris Brough with singles.

Next game for the Griffins will be their home opener, Saturday, April 28th, 8 PM at Earl Armstrong Arena against the Cornwall Celtics.
